

Mid-South Regional Southern Summer Camp

July 9-11, 2019

The Mid-South Region is pleased to announce the southern summer camp at the Tri State Exhibition Center in Cleveland, TN. Camp will be open to all members who are D1 and up. D1s must be able to care for mount, tack mount and ride independently. Groups will be according to certification level and goal is to prep for next certification level. Lessons will be flat, grids and show jump.

Move in date is July 9 after 4pm. Camp will start at 8am on Tuesday and conclude on Thursday afternoon. Each camper will receive 2 mounted lesson on each day as well as unmounted sessions. Will be offering HB/HA topics.

Mounted instructors will be Sarah Morgan and Billie Stewart. Sarah has been a national examiner for over 25 years testing thru A level and a graduate A. She has travel and competed in US as well as Europe. Billie is our returning dressage instructor who is back by popular demand and a silver medalist with USDF as well as her background as national examiner testing to A level dressage.

C2 and up level members are eligible to assist in teaching a HM session for \$50 discount of camp fees. This is a great way to prep for HB. HA candidates will be able to assist in mounted lessons.

Cost of camp is \$175 per camper, including stabling for Mid-South Region. Members outside region will be \$225.

There are camping hookups at facility for \$20/night. Hotels can be found in Ooltewah, TN area. There is a Microtel in Chattanooga that has reasonable as well.
