GRASSHOPPER Dressage Test: 2019 USDF Introductory Test A Stadium: Ground poles

PUDDLEJUMPER Dressage Test: 2019 USDF Introductory Test B Stadium: 12” Cross Rails

PRE STARTER Dressage 2019 USDF Intro B Stadium **18”- 2’** Not timed, there will be some verticals but no spreads

STARTER Dressage 2022 USEA Starter Test, Stadium **2’3”** Not timed, there will be fences with spreads.

HORSE MANAGEMENT: All the *2022 Required Equipment List* is needed for this D Rally except for Utility kit, Equine First Aid Kit and Human First Aid Kit (there will be one of each of these in the HM Office). Note some kits are per individual and some per Team/Tack Room.

VISITS: No one other than competitors, C Advisors or Horse Management personnel may enter the trailer area after set-up Sunday morning (excluding special visiting times). Parents and Chaperones are encouraged to pick a meeting spot outside the trailer area if they would like to meet for lunch.

No cost for ‘C Advisor’ for D1 Competitors. We suggest one C Advisor per 2 or 3 Members.

Online Entry Form Link will be posted prior to Opening Day.

1. Competitor Entry Form (online JotForm) with
2. name of Chaperone (can be shared with several competitors)
3. name of Coach (can be shared with several riders)
4. name of C Advisor if D1
5. name of volunteer (1 per rider)
6. Negative Coggins (name matching entry) downloaded to JotForm
7. Names of those you request to share a tack room with. We will group those that do not request anyone.

NOTE

-Armbands or bracelets with current information for the individual must be worn at all times.

Competitors to supply their own Medical Armbands/Bracelets. The armbands must be worn on the upper arm. If the competitor has small arms, they may need to safety-pin the armband to their sleeve. Armbands are available for purchase from Shop Pony Club.

-NO REFUNDS after closing date. The closing date will be strictly enforced. No late entries accepted.

D1s WILL COMPETE AS INDIVIDUALS. D1s are given appropriate assistance from a C Advisor. A C Advisor is a C1-or-above-rated Pony Club member who directs and assists but does NOT do the work for the D1. This person may NOT be the coach. In a case where no appropriate Pony Clubber is available, a

Pony Club smart parent may be the 'C Advisor' ONLY if their child is not competing in the D1 Rally. **ALL C Advisors under age 21 yrs. must wear a medical armband with signed medical card enclosed, or an approved medical bracelet.**

D2s and D3s will compete as teams of 3-4 riders and a stable manager. No entry fee for stable managers. We will group you with others if you do not have a team.

TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE may change based on numbers of entries:

7:00 – 8:00 Trailer/ horse/ pony/ equipment drop off

8:00 Rally officially starts. Move-in and tack room set-up begins. **ALL** parents, coaches, chaperones, friends, etc. **MUST** leave the trailer/barn area.

9:00 Competitor/Coach/Parent/Chaperone/Volunteer Briefing and Helmet Check

10:30 A.M. Turnout Inspections begin

11:00 A.M. Dressage rides begin

2:00 P.M. Stadium rides begin

Approx 4:30 P.M. Awards presented

AWARDS: Individual ribbons per Division to 6th place.; Overall Team awards to 4th place. Overall HM Awards to 3rd place.

STABLING: There are limited stalls for out of town competitors that need a stall Saturday night. \$35

Veterinarian on call will be posted at the Show Office.

RULES: This Combined Test D Rally will be governed by the USPC Handbook & Rules for Eventing Competition 2022, USPC Horse Management Rulebook 2022, and the 2022 Eventing Annual Newsletter and 2022 Horse Management Annual Newsletter.

COACHES: Coaches must walk the stadium course with the competitors, coach them in the designated warm-up area, and may debrief immediately after rides (5 min. limit). Coaches may also coach for the dressage phase of the competition. This should be their only contact with the competitors. For D1s if the C Advisor is unavailable coaches are welcome to walk competitor to warm up and back to barn.

SCORING: Turnout Inspection and Horse Management will be judged at the HM Certification level of the competitor. **ALL** competitors are scored as individuals, scores are comprised of Stable Management, Turn Out Inspection and Riding Phases

VOLUNTEERS: All parents attending this Rally are **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED** to volunteer. We will make sure you can watch your child compete!!

OTHER INFORMATION:

Horse sharing will be allowed by up to 2 competitors.

Members will compete at the Certification they are at **OPENING** day. Please make sure Certifications are updated in the National System before completing entries.

Dogs: **MUST** be kept on a leash (not to exceed 6 feet in length) or suitably restrained

TRAILER PARKING: All trailers **MUST** be parked in the designated trailer parking area.
