Attire for the Games Rally – see 2022 Mounted Games Rulebook.

Armbands or bracelets with current information for the individual must be worn at all times on the competition grounds. Competitors to supply their own Medical Armbands/Bracelets. The armbands must be worn on the upper arm. If the competitor has small arms, they may need to safety-pin the armband to their sleeve.

ENTRIES:

All Divisions:

\$100.00 per Rider includes stall for Saturday night

All entries must be accompanied with the following:

1. Entry Form (either fill-able pdf or Google Form)
2. Chaperone Form signed by the Chaperone.
3. Coaches form signed by the Coach.
4. Proof of negative Coggins (within 12 months of date of competition).

NOTE: Make sure the name of the horse on the entry form matches the name of the horse on the Coggins.

5. Club check (or personal check if Center member), payment in full for entries.
Make check payable to: Midsouth Region, USPC

Each Team is expected to provide at least 2 volunteers per Team.

All forms will be available on the Midsouth website.

Any changes must be made by the DC or CA no later than Aug 5th.

Stalls for Saturday night are included in the entry fee. Additional nights may be booked and paid for directly through the facility.

Stalls have to be stripped before leaving.

There are a limited number of Games Ponies available to lease. If leasing, you will be **required** to participate in the clinic on Saturday to make sure of suitability.

RULES: The Games Rally will be governed by the USPC HM Handbook & Rules for Competition 2022, USPC Games Rulebook 2022, and the 2022 Games Annual Newsletter and 2022 Horse Management Annual Newsletter.

SCORING: Turnout Inspection and Horse Management will be judged at the HM Certification level of the competitor.

VOLUNTEERS: All parents attending this Rally are STRONGLY ENCOURAGED to volunteer. If you do not sign up for a job, you may be assigned one. You don't have to be a "horse knowledgeable" person to be able to make a significant contribution!

We will make sure you can watch your child compete!

Rally will not be able to start until all volunteer slots are covered.
