Welcome to Dressage Rally and thank you all for competing this year! We are very happy you have joined us and we appreciate all the hard work that goes into being a rally competitor. We know that the preparation, packing, planning, practicing, traveling all takes a lot of time and effort by competitors, coaches, parents, friends and everyone involved in your horse's care too. It's a lot, right?! We get it, and we are glad you think it's worth doing.

There are a few things that are different about rally this year. To help prevent problems and frustration, outlined below are some changes and a few things that might come up.

First, it's going to be **packed** and not by us! There is another LARGE horse show going on during rally this year so be prepared to share the Horse Park. This could make everything take longer from the start of the day and beyond. Driving in, dropping off, parking, moving around with a trailer, getting lunch, everything could take longer because of the congestion. Be prepared, stay calm and allow yourself extra TIME.

Be cautious! Golf carts, bikes, scooters, motorbikes will be buzzing around and people get silly, careless and in a hurry. Please be attentive to your surroundings and stay where you belong. *If you are on a horse, stay on the horse paths. If you are on a bike or scooter, stay **off** the horse paths.* If you are using a golf cart remember that you **must** be a licensed driver. Drive carefully and respectfully at all times. It's fun to zip around the park with your friends but it's no fun when horses get spooked or people and horses get injured, so be smart. Pay attention and maybe leave the earbuds in your pocket.

Some things will be in different rings and/or barns this year. Be prepared ahead of time and know where you are going. Familiarize yourself with the barns, rings, warm up areas and parking.

A little patience and a kindness go a long way. No one likes big crowds and stressful situations, but try to keep in mind that a bad attitude and complaining won't help anyone. Things will happen that we won't like and can't control. It's Pony Club. It's volunteers, parents, kids, weather and PONIES. What could possibly go wrong? :)
