All Divisions:

Round 1: Knockdown Round with Equitation Score

Round 2: Knockdown Round with Jumpoff (Table II.B)

Riders who are clear in their first round continue directly into a jump-off round without leaving the ring.

Round 3: Two-Phase (Power and Speed, Table II.C)

The course is divided into two sections: a power phase and a speed phase.

Riders continue to the speed section only if they go clear in the power section.

\$185 per rider / No charge for Stable Managers. Includes stall starting Friday 3:00PM.

\$50 stall deposit physical check or cash in sealed labeled envelope written to MTPC is required per horse, turned in to the show office upon arrival. Check will be returned when a picture of the clean stall is brought to the office. Barn is used to host weddings, stalls should be cleaned to bare asphalt. Bring a shop vac.

NO shavings available onsite.

Each team is required to provide 2 volunteers.

Teams will consist of 3-4 riders (any certification level D-2 EV or D-2 HSE and higher, teams do not all have to jump the same height) and a stable manager (SM may hold a certification in any discipline, D-2 or higher).

Entries limited to a maximum of 32 riders (barn has 32 stalls). Depending on the number of entries, tack rooms and feed stalls may have to be in trailers. We will let you know after closing date.

Refunds: Before closing date. No refunds after closing date. Partial refunds once costs are covered in case of competition cancellation for weather.

Packets can not be picked up without payment received.

Entries must include:

- Chaperone form signed by the Chaperone, one chaperone per team.
- Coaches form signed by the Coach if using a coach
- Negative Coggins test for each mount.
- Emergency Contact form for each Senior competitor (18 years or older only)
- If juniors and seniors are on the same team, the Consent Form for Juniors to participate on Senior Team will be required.

Please make certain that the horse's name on the Coggins document matches the name on the entry form. This is especially important if the competitor wants to qualify for Championships. These names must match or the entry will not be accepted by the Championships discipline secretary.

PLEASE INFORM YOUR RIDERS THAT **PEACOCK STIRRUPS ARE NO LONGER ALLOWED** FOR USE AT ANY USPC ACTIVITY. Please also check the 2026 rulebook for Article 15 – Safety, as the USPC Safety Committee has made updates to permitted headgear and protective safety vests (policies 0810 and 0830).

AWARDS:

Team Ribbons: 1st-6th Place overall

Team HM Medals: 1st-3rd Place overall

Individual Ribbons: 1st-6th per division

Equitation Medal: 1st place per division

Best Turned Out: 1st place of all entries, chosen by HM judges

STARTING TIMES:

Barns open at 6:00 a.m. Saturday

Turnout inspection and ride times will be listed in competitor's packet and posted at the office.

All competitors are expected to be on site at barn opening time and until barn closing times, regardless of ride times.

RULES:

This Show Jumping Rally will be governed under the 2026 USPC Show Jumping Rulebook, 2026 Show Jumping Newsletter, 2026 Horse Management Handbook, and 2026 Horse Management Newsletter.

Horses may arrive and have stalls set up starting at 3:00 PM.

Team tack and feed room set up may not begin until 8:00 AM Saturday.

8:00 AM Rally Officially starts- ALL parents, coaches, chaperones, friends MUST leave barn.

8:00 AM Tack & Feed Stall set up begins

9:00 AM Competitor/Coach/Parent/Chaperone/Volunteer Briefing and Helmet Check

10:00 AM Horse Inspection

12:00 PM Turnout Inspections begin

12:45 PM Round 1

Turnbacks after round 1

1:00-5:00 as teams are available- Required Equipment checks

5:30 PM Barn Closes & Course 2 open for walking
