It's been a super busy few months!

We offered zoom meetings for Rally Q & A's at the end of May, participation was low, though there were lots of questions asked via other sources.

We started June off with Camp in Nashville, we had 24 participants, from 3 Clubs and Centers, and some fantastic instruction. Mega Rally came next, competitor numbers were up for every Rally. The Horse Trial entries also increased from 2023.

Straight after the Horse Trial we were in to getting Members situated for Championships, where we had 40 participants over 6 disciplines. We also had many Members participate in Education. An Upper Level Dressage Test took place in Louisville at the beginning of July, with 4 Midsouth participants. We also had 3 Members take their HB at Festival.
